NOTES:

1. All visitors must complete a Membership Form, either on paper or using the website form.
2. The "local" Introductory Flight discount is at the discretion of the duty pilot and applies to "pay on the day" visitors only (not to gift vouchers). The discount may also be offered on vouchers at events such as the Food Festival at the discretion of the Committee.
3. Summer course week flying fees (and temporary membership if applicable) are charged at member rates. Courses must be pre-booked with a non-refundable deposit of £280.00 which is deductible against flying fees incurred during the week
4. Only one block course may be taken in any 12 month period. These are intended as introductory courses only. Membership fees apply pro rata at normal rates if flying is not completed within the period. (See Member's price list)
5. All Introductory Flights and Course prices include temporary membership (3 or 6 months depending on the type of package purchased). Continuation of the membership during this period is conditional on the member participating in club activities at least once in every four weeks.
6. The "Mile high" flight tow is to 5,000' above airfield level (5,325' amsl). In the event that cloud prevents attainment of the height then two standard 2,000 tow flights may be substituted by agreement with the customer.
7. Indicative maximum flight times (subject to weather) are Introductory Flight, up to 30 minutes; Extended Introductory Flight, up to 40 minutes, Mile High, up to one hour
